CHANGES TO **SCHOOL ZONES**

Starting
September 1



 **City of
Saskatoon**

Heads up for back-to-school! Changes to School Zones and new Playground Zones will be in effect on September 1, 2022

1. New Playground Zones with a reduced speed limit of **30 km/h**.
2. School Zones and Playground Zones in effect from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m. every day, all year**.
3. Length of some school zones will change; School Zones End signs for certain streets.
4. High schools will be designated as “School Area” with no reduced speeds; however, U- turns are still restricted.

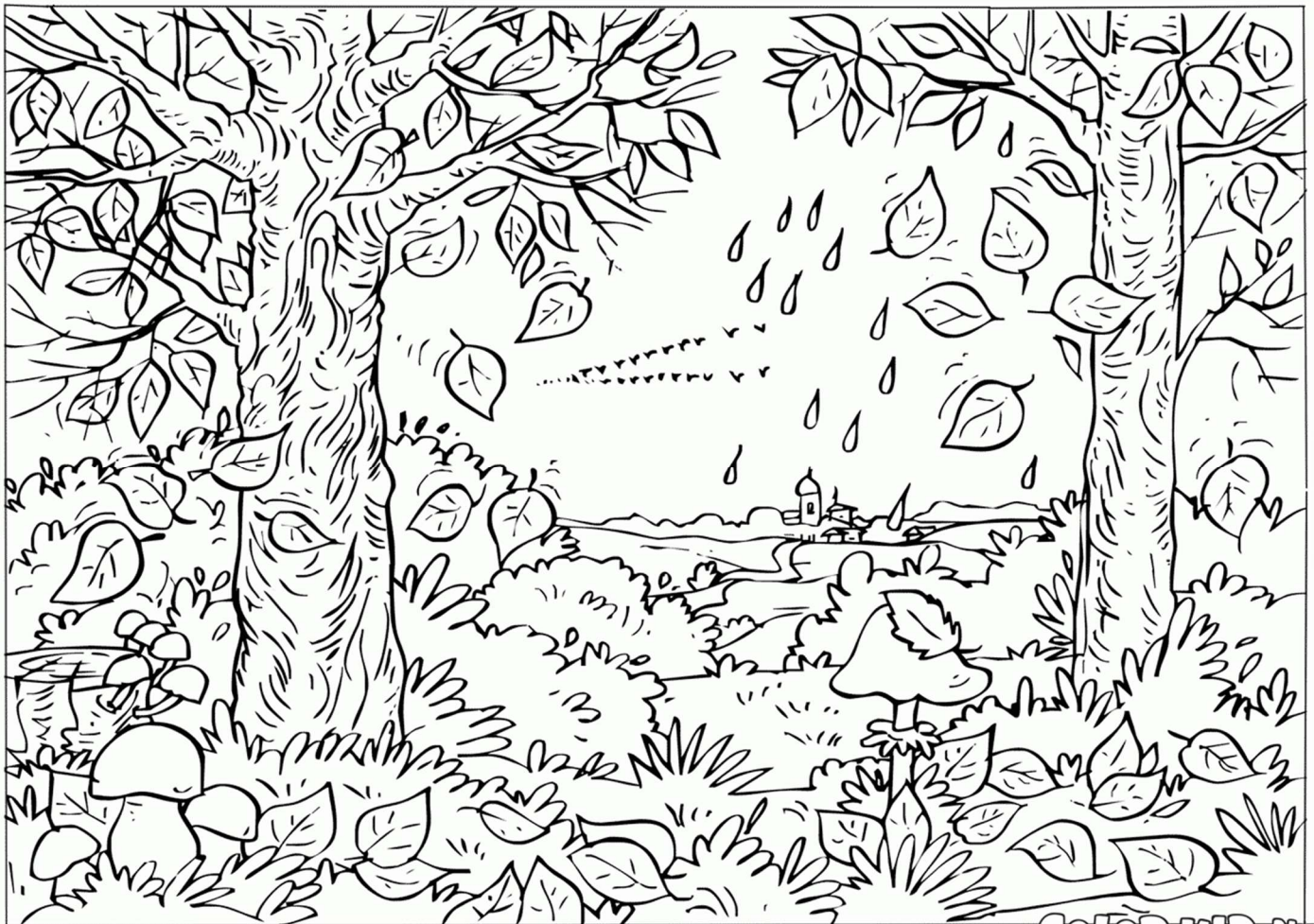

At Work, At Home, Make Safety Known

Property Maintenance and Safety

Property maintenance inspections are completed by the Saskatoon Fire Department when a Property Maintenance Complaint is submitted. Under the Property Maintenance & Nuisance Abatement Bylaw 8175, homeowners in the City of Saskatoon are responsible for ensuring yards are kept clean, safe and free from:

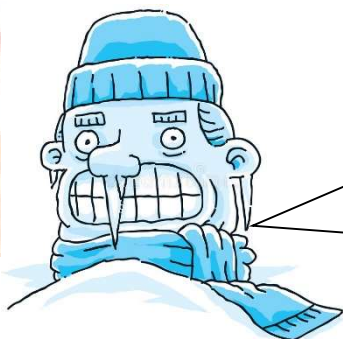
- Garbage and junk
- Junked vehicles and dismantled machinery
- Weeds and grass taller than 20cm (8 inches)
- Holes and excavations that could cause an accident
- Rodents, vermin and insects
- Areas that may allow water to pool

To report an unsightly property, submit a Property Maintenance Complaint online at Saskatoon.ca or call the **Property Maintenance & Safety Hotline: 306-975-2828**.

Vacant Buildings

If a building is vacant, abandoned or unoccupied and poses a hazard to public health or safety it must be secured against unauthorized entry:

- if you can, contact the owner and have the owner secure the building so that it can not be easily entered. This would mean that all doors and windows that are accessible be boarded up with ½ inch OSB or plywood and secured with 2 inch wood screws.
- if you cannot contact the owner or the owner fails to secure the building to your satisfaction, call the Saskatoon Fire Department for appropriate action. After regular business hours or on weekends, contact the Safety and Property Maintenance Hotline **306-975-2828**.
