

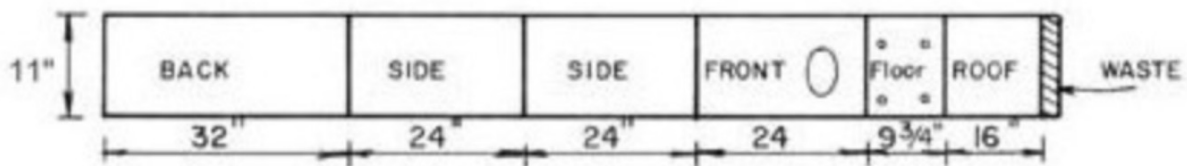
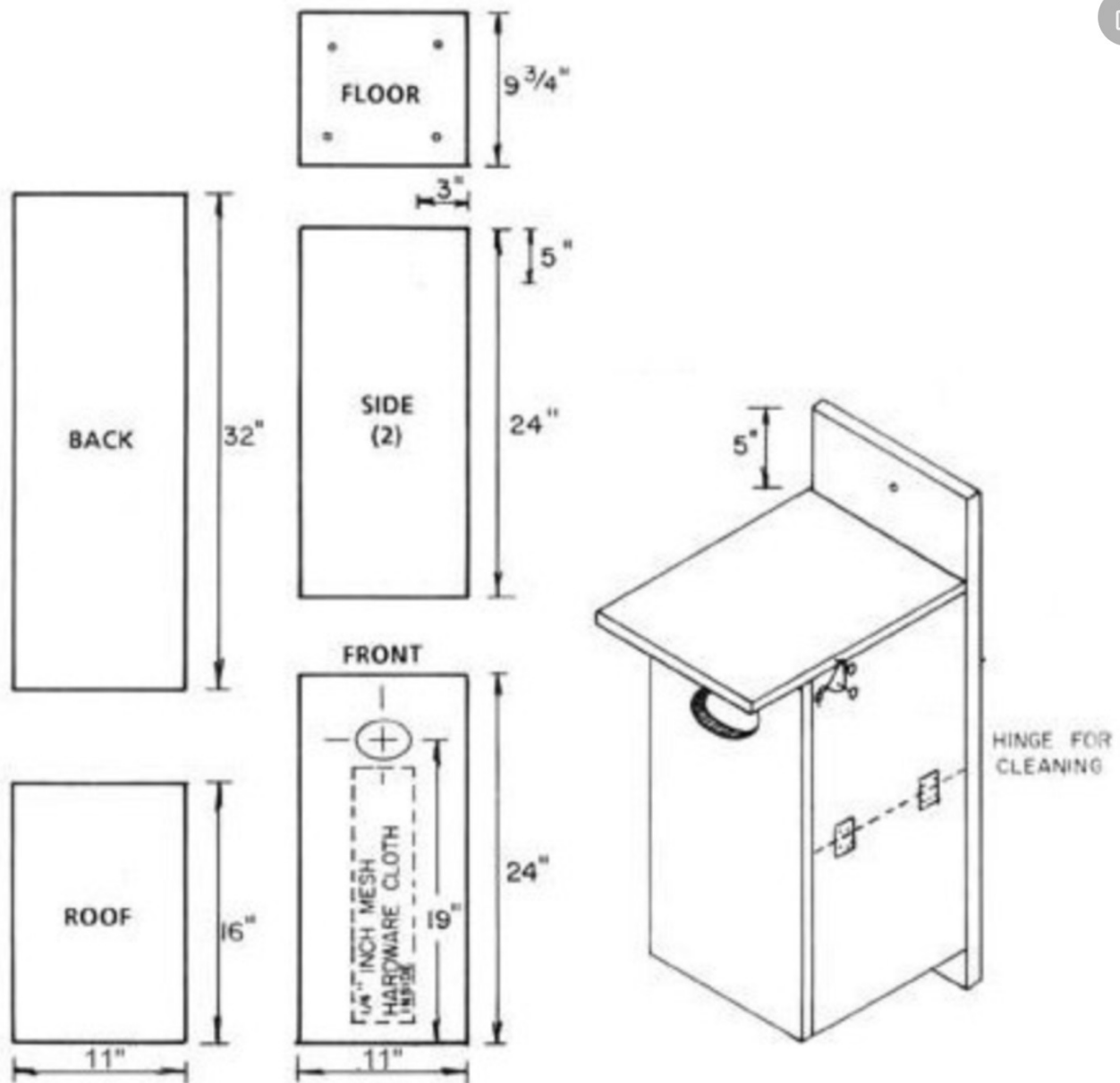

#### School Zones in effect September 1, 2020

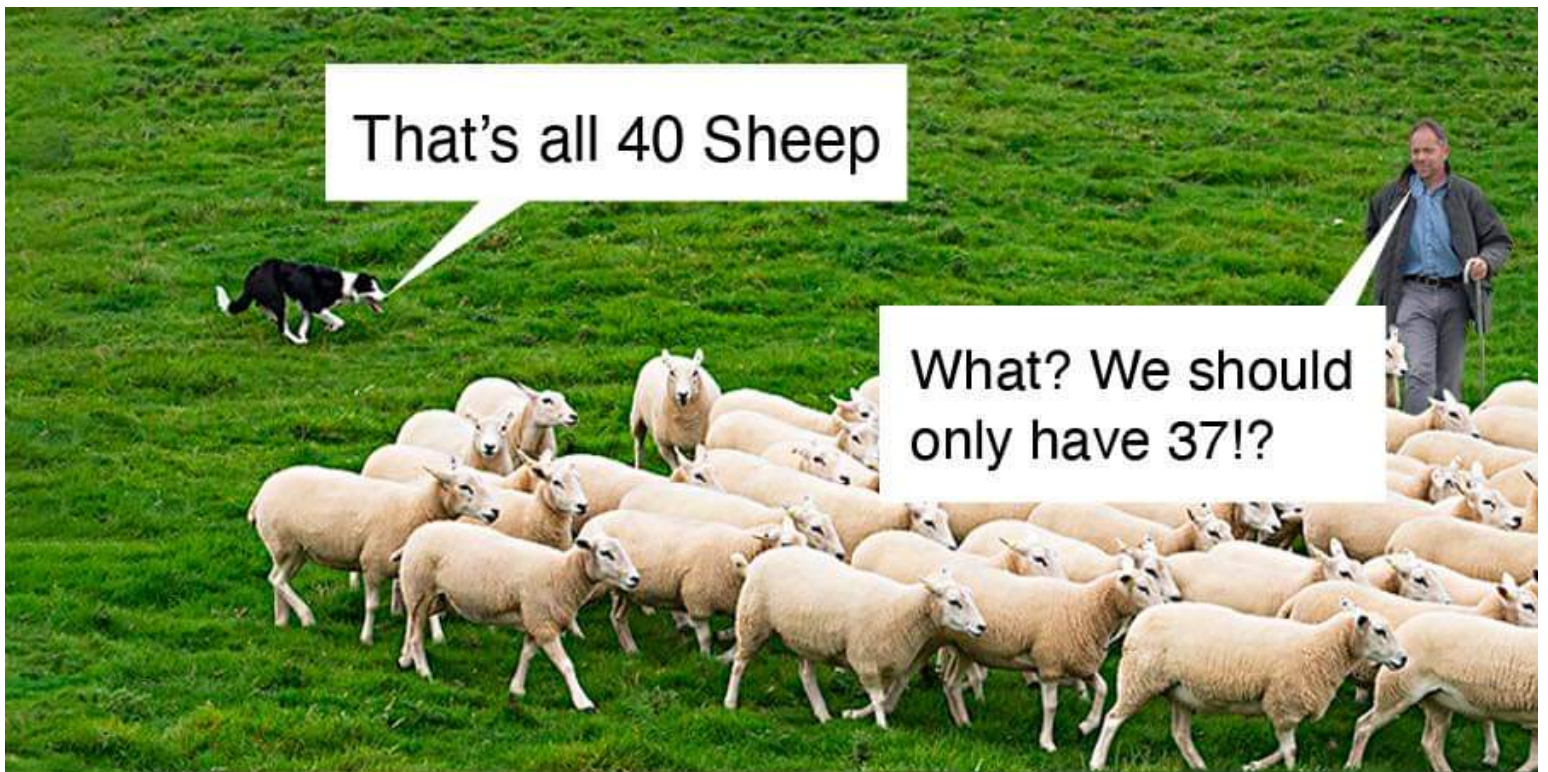
The City reminds drivers that school zone speed limits are back in effect Tuesday, September 1. School zones are marked around all public and private schools (elementary and secondary), [Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m.](#) to 5:00 p.m., from September to June. Drivers are required to reduce their speeds to a maximum of 30 kilometres per hour. The reduced speed limit gives motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians more time to react in an unexpected situation.

The fine for speeding in school zones starts at \$170. For more on penalties, [visit the SGI website](#).

The City also wants to remind Saskatoon drivers that U-turns are restricted in school zones. The best way to keep children safe in a school zone is to maximize visibility, ensuring that each child can see and be seen by drivers in the area. Rather than perform a U-turn, drive around the block (or use the roundabout, depending on the school site). The fine for completing a U-turn in a school zone is \$90. Getting children to and from school safely is everyone's responsibility. Please travel responsibly.
