Finally, I would like to thank everyone who pitched in for the 2019 Community Clean-up back on May 11<sup>th</sup>. It was so encouraging seeing many new faces join in the effort to clear our back alleys and tidy up our boulevards and public spaces. This year, we partnered with our neighbours in Riversdale to tackle both communities on the same day. According to the City, we collectively removed over 12,000 kilograms of junk from back alleys, including 940 kilograms of metal and 83 tires for recycling.

Best of all, the cleanup was complete in record time: what has taken all day in years past was accomplished by about 1:00 in the afternoon. For this, I would like to thank all the residents of King George collectively for keeping our neighbourhood cleaner throughout the year. I think that pride in this place we call home is growing, as it should!

## ***Principal's message from King George Community School***

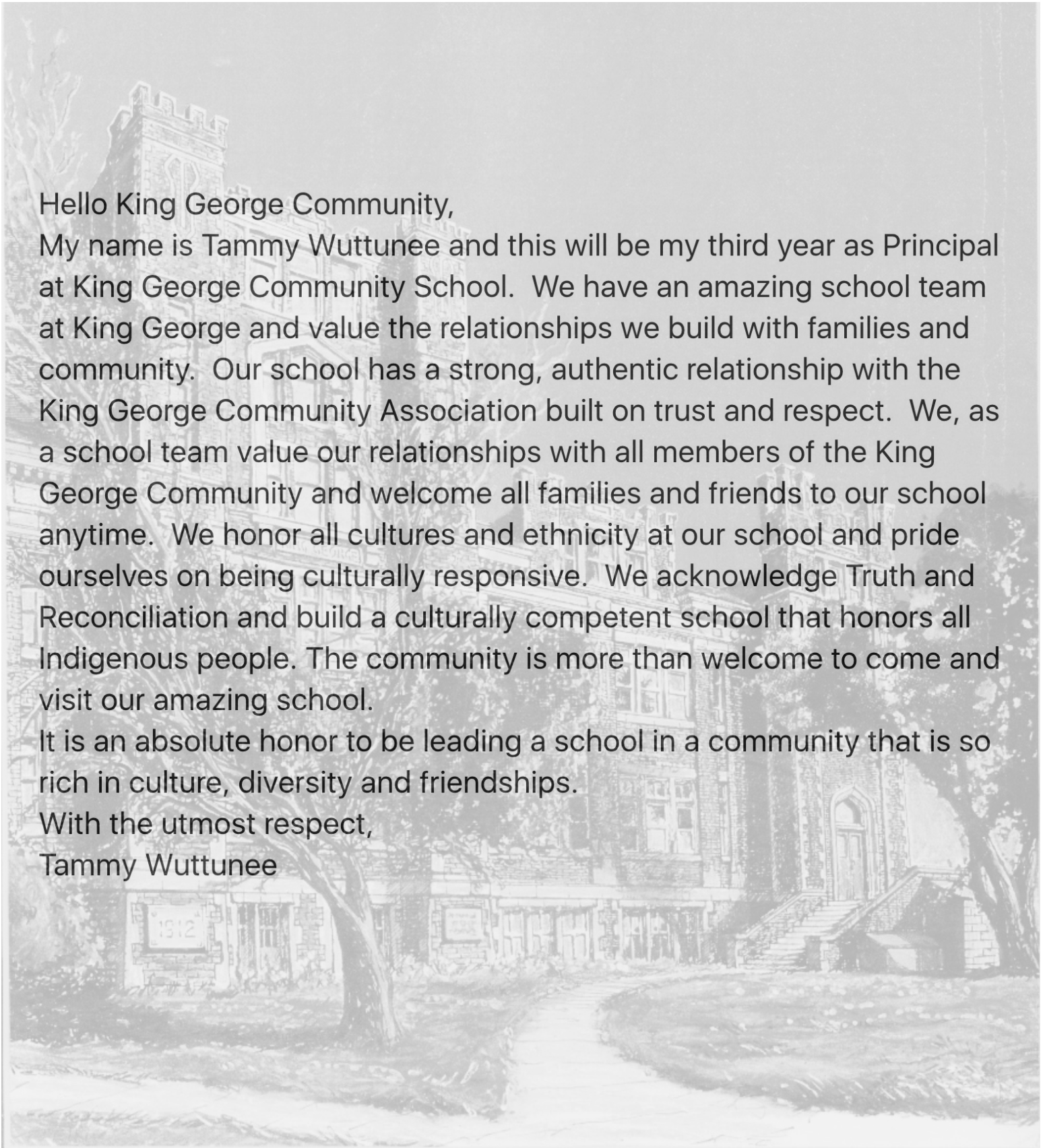
Hello King George Community,

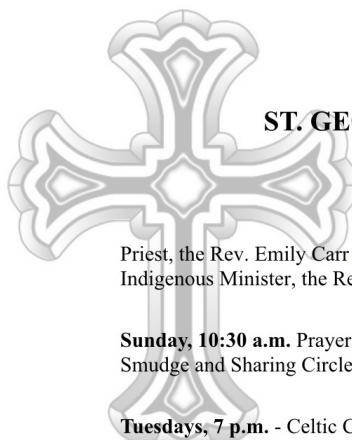

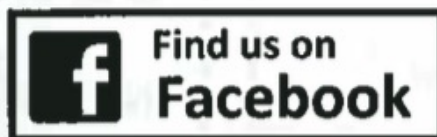
