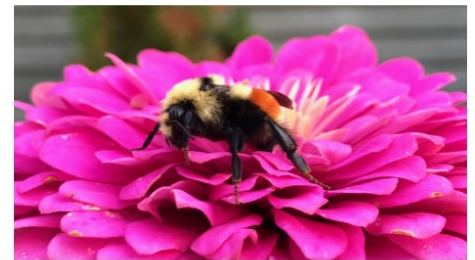

PLEASE, protect our bees

The western bee is now the single most prolific pollinator of our time. 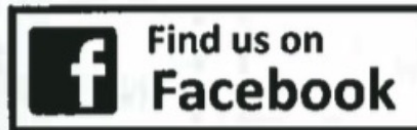
